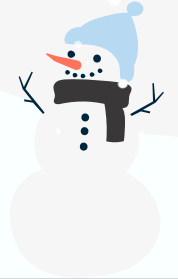

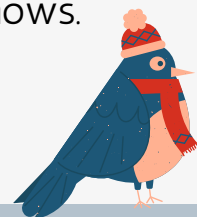
Harvard Friends of the Arts Concerts

If you, or someone you know has difficulty getting to the library, either temporarily or on a long term basis, we are happy to help!

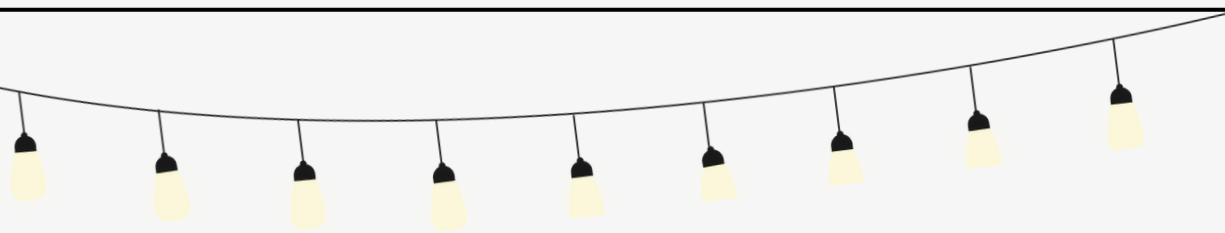
