Students in Grades 6-12

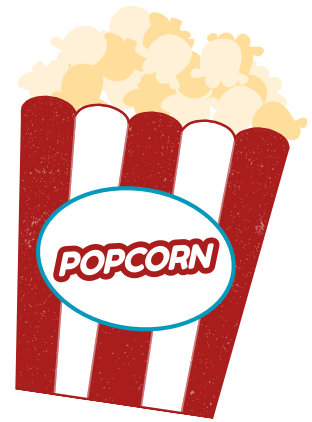
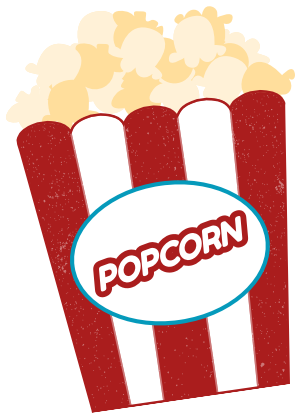
On the first Thursday of every month, we will show a movie afterschool.

Popcorn and water will be available.

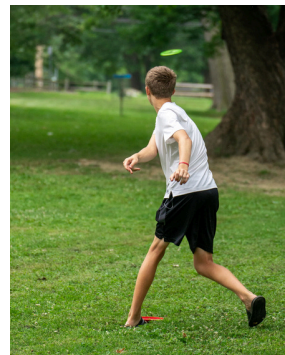

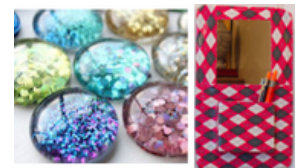
